

Objective:

It covers both the anatomy and the physiology of the human body's 11 organ systems in detail. In order to take this course, the student MUST have completed a first year biology course AND a first-year chemistry course.

Along with lecture, there will be laboratory experiments to provide hands on reenforcement of concepts presented during lecture. This includes frank illustrations and descriptions.
